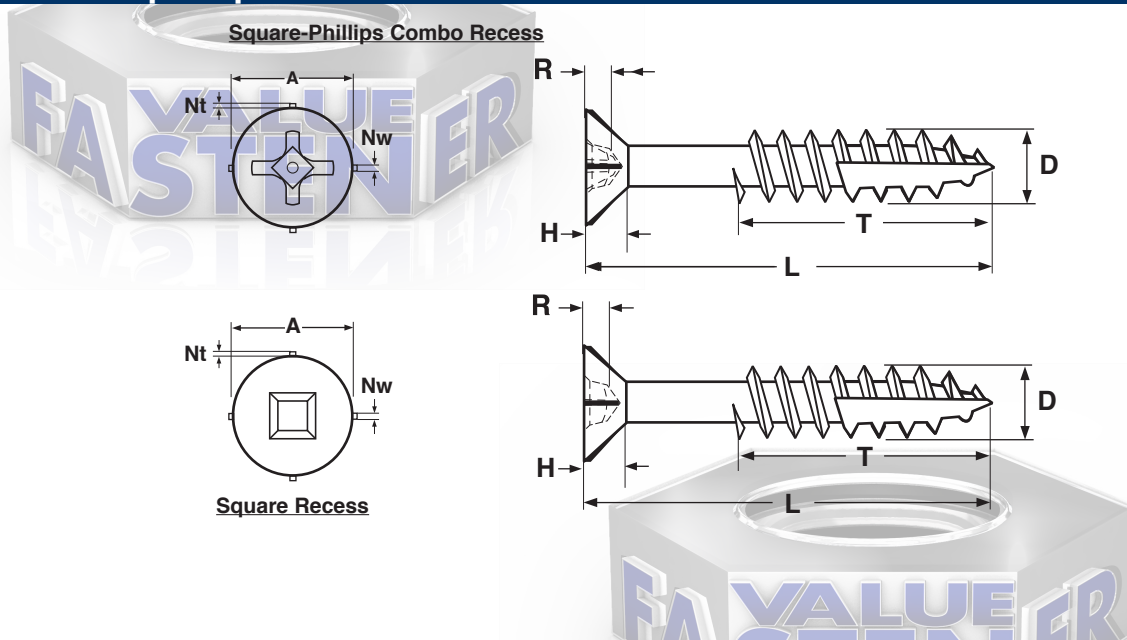

<b>Description</b>	An externally threaded fastener with a countersunk head, crossed recess that will also accept a square driver bit, a single lead thread and a shank with a reduced diameter. The head diameter is 90% its normal size. The nibs on the underside of the head aid in the countersinking process by removing additional material. The shank has a reduced diameter and a chip cavity cut out where the final several threads end at the tip.
<b>Applications / Advantages</b>	The deeper thread design offers greater resistance to pull-out forces. The nibs on the bearing surface of the head helps the screw seat flush. The type-17 point enables faster starting. The recess design allows for multiple drive tools. Popular use is in cabinet assembly.
